Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

Words with capitalized initial letters have defined meanings under the conditions below. These definitions apply whether the terms appear in singular or plural form.

Account	A unique account created for you to access our Service or parts of our Service.
Affiliate	An entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest, or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.

Cookies	Small files placed on your computer, mobile device, or any other device by a website, containing details of your browsing history on that website among other uses.

Device	Any device that can access the Service, such as a computer, cell phone, or digital tablet.
Personal Data	Any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual. Also referred to as "Personal Information." These terms are used interchangeably unless a specific law requires otherwise.
Service	Refers to the Website.
Service Provider	Any natural or legal person who processes data on behalf of the Company, including third-party companies or individuals employed to facilitate the Service, provide the Service, perform related services, or assist in analyzing how the Service is used.
Usage Data	Data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

You	The individual accessing or using the Service, or the company or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you, including but not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Phone number

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Service and may include:

- Your device's Internet Protocol (IP) address

- Browser type and version
- Pages of our Service that you visit
- Time and date of your visit
- Time spent on those pages
- Unique device identifiers
- Other diagnostic data

When you access the Service through a mobile device, we may also automatically collect:

- Type of mobile device
- Mobile device unique ID
- IP address of your mobile device
- Mobile operating system
- Type of mobile Internet browser
- Unique device identifiers
- Other diagnostic data

Tracking Technologies and Cookies

We use Cookies and similar tracking technologies to track activity on our Service and store certain information. These technologies include beacons, tags, and scripts used to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our Service.

****Types of tracking technologies we use:****

- ****Cookies or Browser Cookies**** — Small files placed on your device. You can instruct your browser to refuse all Cookies or indicate when a Cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept Cookies, you may not be able to use some parts of our Service.
- ****Web Beacons**** — Small electronic files (also called clear gifs, pixel tags, or single-pixel gifs) contained in certain sections of our Service and emails. These permit the Company to count users who have visited pages or opened emails and gather other related website statistics.

****Cookie duration:****

- ****Session Cookies**** — Deleted as soon as you close your web browser.
- ****Persistent Cookies**** — Remain on your device when you go offline until they expire or are deleted.

****Consent for non-essential cookies:**** Where required by law, we use non-essential cookies (such as analytics, advertising, and remarketing cookies) only with your consent. You can withdraw or change your consent at any time using our cookie preferences tool (if available) or through your browser/device settings. Withdrawing consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

****Cookies we use:****

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

Purpose	Description
Provide and maintain our Service	Including monitoring the usage of our Service. **Manage your Account** Manage your registration as a user and provide access to different functionalities available to registered users. **Performance of a contract** Development, compliance, and undertaking of purchase contracts for products, items, or services you have purchased, or any other contract with us through the Service. **Contact you** By email, telephone, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication regarding updates or informative communications related to functionalities, products, or contracted services, including security updates. **Provide information** News, special offers, and general information about goods, services, and events similar to those you have already purchased or inquired about, unless you have opted not to receive such information. **Manage your requests** Attend to and manage your requests to us. **Business transfers** Evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets. **Other purposes** Data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of promotional campaigns, and evaluating and improving our Service, products, services, marketing, and your experience.

Sharing Your Personal Data

We may share your Personal Data in the following situations:

- **With Service Providers** — To monitor and analyze use of our Service and to contact you.
- **For business transfers** — In connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of Company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business.
- **With Affiliates** — We will require affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners, or other companies that we control or that are under common control with us.
- **With business partners** — To offer you certain products, services, or promotions.
- **With other users** — If our Service offers public areas, information you share or interactions in public areas may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed.
- **With your consent** — We may disclose your Personal Data for any other purpose with your consent.

Retention of Your Personal Data

The Company will retain your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

Where possible, we apply shorter retention periods and/or reduce identifiability by deleting, aggregating, or anonymizing data. Unless otherwise stated, the retention periods below are maximum periods ("up to") and we may delete or anonymize data sooner when it is no longer needed.

Chat transcripts	Up to 24 months	Quality assurance and staff training.
Website analytics data (cookies, IP addresses, device identifiers)	Up to 24 months from collection	Analyze trends while respecting privacy principles.
Server logs (IP addresses, access times)	Up to 24 months	Security monitoring and troubleshooting.

Extended Retention

We may retain Personal Data beyond the periods stated above for the following reasons:

- **Legal obligation** — We are required by law to retain specific data (e.g., financial records for tax authorities).
- **Legal claims** — Data is necessary to establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.
- **Your explicit request** — You ask us to retain specific information.
- **Technical limitations** — Data exists in backup systems scheduled for routine deletion.

You may request information about how long we will retain your Personal Data by contacting us.

Data Disposal Procedures

When retention periods expire, we securely process Personal Data as follows:

- **Deletion** — Personal Data is removed from our systems and no longer actively processed.
- **Backup retention** — Residual copies may remain in encrypted backups for a limited period consistent with our backup schedule and are not restored except where necessary for security, disaster recovery, or legal compliance.
- **Anonymization** — In some cases, we convert Personal Data into anonymous statistical data that cannot be linked back to you. This anonymized data may be retained indefinitely for research and analytics.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. This means that information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of your state, province, country, or other governmental jurisdiction where data protection laws may differ from those in your jurisdiction.

Where required by applicable law, we will ensure that international transfers of your Personal Data are subject to appropriate safeguards and supplementary measures where appropriate. The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy. No transfer of your Personal Data will take place to an organization or country unless there are adequate controls in place, including the security of your data and other personal information.

Deleting Your Personal Data

You have the right to delete or request that we assist in deleting the Personal Data that we have collected about you.

****How to delete your data:****

- ****Through the Service**** — Sign in to your Account (if you have one) and visit the account settings section to manage your personal information.
- ****By contacting us**** — Request access to, correction of, or deletion of any Personal Data that you have provided to us.

Please note that we may need to retain certain information when we have a legal obligation or lawful basis to do so.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Transactions

If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition, or asset sale, your Personal Data may be transferred. We will provide notice before your Personal Data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

Law Enforcement

Under certain circumstances, the Company may be required to disclose your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g., a court or government agency).

Other Legal Requirements

The Company may disclose your Personal Data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:

- Comply with a legal obligation
- Protect and defend the rights or property of the Company
- Prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the Service
- Protect the personal safety of users of the Service or the public
- Protect against legal liability

Security of Your Personal Data

The security of your Personal Data is important to us, but no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially reasonable means to protect your Personal Data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Children's Privacy

Our Service does not address anyone under the age of 16. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 16.

If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided us with Personal Data, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected Personal Data from anyone under the age of 16 without verification of parental consent, we take steps to remove that information from our servers.
